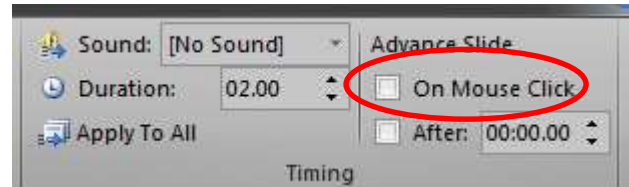


## Directions for Making a Basic Maze

1. Open New PowerPoint- Blank Presentation. (Ctrl+N)
2. Make a slide explaining that this is a maze game- user needs to stay in the lines.
  - 2a. Insert a shape with the words START or BEGIN on it.
  - 2b. Right-click on the small slide at the left and choose “duplicate slide”
  - 2c. -Delete the text on slide 2 that explains the game.
3. Insert a rectangle shape that covers the **entire slide**.
  - Right click on the rectangle and choose send to back from the menu.
4. Insert freeform shape that looks like a maze (double click to close shape) (click format menu- choose shape fill) (choose shape effects and shadow outer)
5. Insert a shape at the end for a finish button (Can be a shape or a graphic)
6. Create a new slide (Ctrl+m) make this slide the LOSER slide (I used word art- you could use a graphic or anything.)
7. Create a new slide
  - This will be your WINNER slide
  - Add a graphic and even a sound (if you want to be creative!!)
8. Insert 2 shapes on this slide. 1 for level 2 , and 1 for restart.

Learning targets: Students will use shapes, hyperlinks and formatting tools in PPT to create an educational game.

9. Now add in the HYPERLINKS using INSERT -> ACTION  
Go to Slide 1:  
Click on TRANSITIONS and uncheck the box for ADVANCE ON MOUSE CLICK:

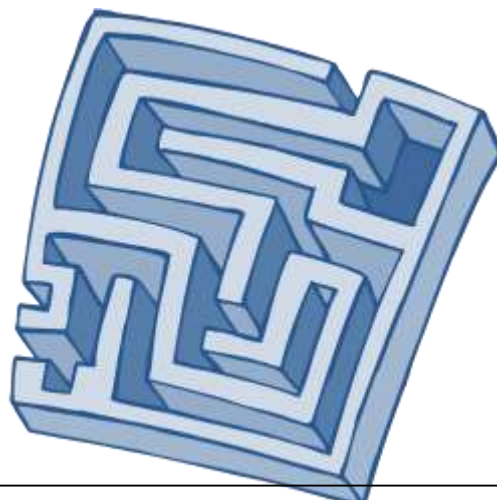


YOU WILL NEED TO DO THIS FOR EVERY SLIDE!!

10. Click on your “start” shape and add an ACTION. (so that on click- go to slide 2).
11. GO TO SLIDE 2 – Add an action on the rectangle shape (the background) that on MOUSE OVER- it goes to the loser slide.
12. Add an action on your “finish” shape that on MOUSE OVER – it goes to the “winner” slide

This is the BASICS!!

ADD another level and make it educational (Add a math, English, science or even technology component)
